





# NYC REGATTA 2024 Signalling Flags

1. Class flags: MAIN FLEET: (Delta)





JUNIOR FLEET: (Lima)



## 2. Start sequence:

The meanings of visual and sound signals are stated below. An arrow pointing up or down (↑ or ↓) means that a visual signal is displayed or removed. A dot (·) means a short sound, a long dash (—) means a long sound.

Time	Signal	Flag	Sound
5 min	Warning	CLASS FLAG ↑	·
4 min	Prep	 ↑	·
1 min	One min	 ↓	—
Start	Start	CLASS FLAG ↓	·

## 3. Other signals:

Signal	Flag	Sound	Notes
Racing will commence shortly (NYC only)		↑ .. ↓ ·	The warning signal will be made 1 minute after removal unless at that time the race is <i>postponed</i>
Postponement		↑ .. ↓ ·	Races not started are <i>postponed</i> . The warning signal will be made 1 minute after removal unless at that time the race is <i>postponed</i> again or <i>abandoned</i> .
Individual Recall		↑ · ↓	The flag shall be displayed until all such boats have sailed completely to the pre-start side of the starting line but no later than four minutes after the starting signal
General Recall		↑ .. ↓ ·	If unable to identify boats that are on the course side of the starting line or there has been an error in the starting procedure, the race committee may signal a general recall. The warning signal for a new start for the recalled class shall be made one minute after flag removed

<b>Shortened Course</b>		↑ ..	<p>The finishing line shall be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(a) At a rounding <i>mark</i>, between the <i>mark</i> and a staff displaying flag S;</li> <li>(b) A line the course requires boats to cross</li> <li>(c) At a gate, between the gate <i>marks</i></li> </ul> <p>The shortened course shall be signalled before the first boat crosses the finishing line</p>
<b>Abandon</b>		↑ ...	
<b>Finish</b>		·	Where possible but not necessary
